

Christian movie review 13 hours

The movie 13 hours was only 2 hours long, but gripping all the way. What most people don't know is how true it is in fulfillment of Bible verses and especially Bible prophecy. Most don't understand what we proved biblically and historically in our book, <http://bookstore.westbowpress.com/Products/SKU-000603814/Hidden-Truth-from-ProphecyBeyond-2012.aspx>, that America is the principal nation of Israel.

Seeing the US flag in ignominy during the film reflects the shame America has experienced and that God prophesied as she falls from being the world's greatest power to a weakling militarily and financially, not to mention spiritually.

We live in a world of lies as Isaiah saw in Isaiah 6, a world led in lies by the biggest liar of them all, the US and its leadership who lied about Benghazi, led by a new world order that has established the lies. The mission of our assembly, to warn the nation that it is has forsaken the commands of God (Isa. 58:1-2), as well as its leaders whose hands are "stained with blood." That includes the blood of brave young men and even a US ambassador who were left unaided by a nation that was once had the will and the power to protect its own. The nation has lost its "pride of power" (Lev. 26:19), and Jesus promised He would break that pride, and He has as America has sunk deeper and deeper into moral depravity.

The last part of Isaiah 59 declares that Jesus will come personally to correct the situation of lies and lawlessness. The true gospel of the Kingdom says He's coming back to restore the good laws of His Kingdom of Love.
